13 CLIMATE ACTION



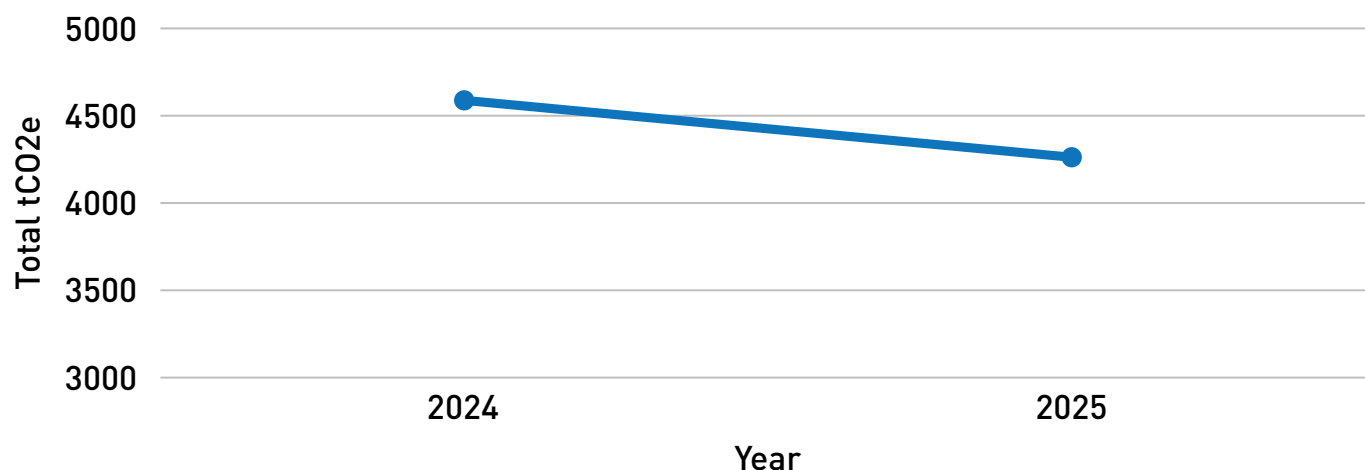

After measuring our progress for 2 years we are pleased to report a 7% decrease in our Scope 1 and 2 Emissions in this period.

In particular, we are committed to creating items made from sustainably sourced raw materials.

Site Environmental Targets

Our primary objective is to limit increases in electricity, gas and vehicle fuel consumption to no more than 5% in a year. With the growth of the overall business we feel that this target still allows for a consistent and reliable performance.

Environmental Product Declarations are a standardised, third party report detailing a product's life cycle environmental impacts. Although these are currently voluntary we recognise the increasing need for them. We will be looking into the requirements needed to produce these.


Recycling
